ASHE Putting Contest Rules 2013

- 1. Contest is open to all participants of the tournament. One putt per player. There is no cost to putt for the \$5000 prize. Participant may elect to pay \$5 for a \$\$\$ prize pool.**
- 2. Participants to attempt a qualifying putt during tournament.**
- 3. Putts will be measured from the edge of the cup to the edge of the ball.**
- 4. The closest five qualifying putters will compete in a final putt off after dinner and before the awards presentation. All participants who sink the qualifying putt (even over five) will be eligible for the final putt off, also ties for fifth closest will also advance. You must be present to putt in the final putt off, no substitutions.**
- 5. The closest five putters will compete for the \$\$\$ prize and a chance to attempt a long putt for \$5000 and the \$\$\$ prize.**
- 6. The putting order for the contestants in the final putt off will be picked at random. Contestants will not be allowed to witness/view the putts before theirs. In the event of a tie during the final putt off, additional putts will be conducted to break the tie for the prize. Prize \$\$\$ will be given to 1st and 2nd closest who paid the \$5.**
- 7. The final winner of the putting contest will then have the opportunity to sink one long putt for \$5000.**
